The City of Decatur Board of Public Works and Safety Members met in Special Meeting on Wednesday, April 15, 2026 at 9:16 a.m. at City Hall in Council Chambers, 172 N. Second Street, Decatur. Members present were Tyler Fullenkamp, Craig Coshow and Mayor Rickord. Also present were Clerk-Treasurer Eran Hackman and City Attorney Anne Razo.

Notice of the Special Meeting was posted in City Hall at least 48 hours before meeting. The *Decatur Daily Democrat*, the *Berne Witness* and *WZBD* were also notified. The notice was also posted on the City of Decatur's website.

Per Attorney Anne Razo, it was brought to the board's attention in executive session regarding alleged property damage to a city resident's home that was discussed and addressed. A special meeting is being held to consider a motion to make a settlement offer for resolution of the claim. Fullenkamp made a motion to offer the property owner a satisfaction waiver and release of all alleged issues that have been addressed and make that available to the property owner. Seconded by Coshow. The motion was adopted.
