Board of Public Works & Safety Minutes
December 2, 2025

The City of Decatur Board of Public Works and Safety Members met on Tuesday, December 2, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall in Council Chambers, 172 N. Second Street, Decatur. Members present were Craig Coshow, Tyler Fullenkamp, and Mayor Dan Rickord. Also present were Clerk-Treasurer Eran Hackman and City Attorney Anne Razo.

The Clerk-Treasurer had emailed the minutes from the November 18, 2025 meeting. Coshow made a motion to adopt the minutes of November 18, 2025 as emailed. Seconded by Fullenkamp, the motion was adopted.

The first item on the agenda was Fire Chief Jeff Sheets seeking permission to hire Brad Roe as a paid on-call firefighter. Fullenkamp made a motion to permit Chief Sheets to hire Brad Roe as a paid on-call firefighter. Seconded by Coshow, the motion was adopted.

Fire Chief Jeff Sheets noted he is awaiting the physical examination reports for two individuals which would put the force at full status.

City Attorney Anne Razo shared the lease with Conner Brite's Wildflowers at the MERIT Center is up for renewal. The lease is a straight renewal. Per Attorney Razo, the rent has been adjusted due to increases. Coshow made a motion to renew the lease with Conner Brite's Wildflowers at the MERIT Center and authorized Mayor Rickord to sign the lease. Seconded by Fullenkamp, the motion was adopted.

There being no further business to be brought before the Board, Coshow made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Fullenkamp, the motion passed.
